



DATA PROTECTION POLICY

This Data Protection Policy has been prepared on behalf of all the companies of the Lifebrain Group located in Italy (hereinafter: the "Laboratory or Laboratories" or "we"), the complete list of which is at the end of this document.

The companies of the Lifebrain Group believe it is important to protect privacy and, for this reason, they are constantly committed, while continuing to provide their usual high-quality services, to guarantee the respect and protection of privacy rights.

This document is intended to provide information on the methods of processing any data that may be collected during access to our websites or in visits to the premises of the Group companies as a customer, supplier or any other business partner.

We, therefore, ask you to read the following Data Protection Policy carefully.

The Laboratories respect and protect the rights to data protection and privacy. Furthermore, they adopt all the measures required by law for the protection of users' personal data that may be processed. The Laboratories are the "Data Controllers" for data protection in relation to the personal data processing activities described below. In this Data Protection Policy, you can quickly and easily get an overview of the personal data being processed, as well as the purposes and legal basis of this processing. Furthermore, you can find information on the (potential) recipients of the data and on data protection rights, also known as the rights of data subjects. Using the contact details given above, the user can contact the Laboratories at any time with questions and suggestions relating to data protection and assert their rights as a data subject.

1. Website usage

1.1. Each time our website is visited, our server collects a series of general data and information which is stored in the server's log files. The server log files record (1) the browser types and versions of the access system used, (2) the operating system used by the access system, (3) the web page from which an access system reaches our website (known as the "Referrer"), (4) the web subpages that are activated on our website using an access system, (5) the date and time of access to the website, (6) the Internet Protocol address (IP address) of the access system, and (7) the Internet Service Provider of the access system. These data do not allow us to identify the data subject who is using the access system. This information is necessary, however, to (a) provide the contents of our website correctly, (b) organise and optimise its contents, and (c) ensure the long-term functionality

of our systems and website technology. The collected data are then

evaluated both statistically and to facilitate the continued technical operation of our website. This also enables us to improve data protection and security in such a way as to guarantee our overall aim of providing an optimal level of protection for the data we process. There are no legal or contractual obligations requiring the user to provide their personal data. However, in some cases, if the data are not provided, it will not be possible to (completely) fulfil the aforementioned purposes. The data will be stored for the purposes indicated above for a period of six months. There is no automated decision-making process, including profiling, pursuant to Article 22 (1 and 4) of the GDPR. The processing takes place on the legal basis of the legitimate interests described above (Article 6 (1) (f) GDPR), with users able, on grounds relating to their particular situation, to exercise a right to object (Article 21 of the GDPR – for details see below, in the section on the rights of the data subject) in certain cases.

- 1.2. Our website uses 'cookies' that process personal data (or make this processing possible). Cookies are text files that are retained and stored on the user's computer through their browser, unless the user has set their browser not to allow cookies. Our website uses the cookies listed below. There is no automated decision-making process, including profiling, pursuant to Article 22 (1 and 4) of the GDPR:

- 1.3. In addition to the cookies listed above, our website also sets third-party cookies, as well as the following tools/services, which provide us with analysis of the use of our website and the display of advertisements on it:

On our website, we have integrated the Google Analytics component with the anonymisation function ("_gat._anonymizeIp"), which allows Google to truncate and anonymise the IP address of the Internet connection of the data subject, if access to our pages web takes place from a Member State of the European Union or from another state that is party to the Agreement on the European Economic Area. Google Analytics is a website statistics service, which detects, collects and evaluates data based on the user's behaviour on web pages. A website statistics service detects, for example, the data of the web page (known as the "Referrer") that the data subject arrived from, the sub-pages accessed, or the frequency and duration of the visit to a particular subpage. Website statistics are mainly used to optimise a website and for a cost/benefit analysis of web advertising.

The purpose of the Google Analytics component is to analyse visitor flows on our website. The processing takes place on the legal basis of legitimate interest (Article 6 (1) (f) GDPR), with users able, on grounds relating to their particular situation, to exercise a right to object (Article 21 of the GDPR – for details see below, in the section on the rights of the data subject) in certain cases. Google also uses the data and information obtained to evaluate the use of our website, to compile online reports that list the activities conducted on it, and to provide additional services related to the use of our web pages.

Google Analytics sets a cookie, which allows Google to analyse how our website is used. As part of this technical process, Google comes into possession of personal data – such as the IP address of the data subject – which is required, for example, to trace the origin of visitors and clicks, and subsequently to calculate the fees due to it.

As previously described, users can always block the use of cookies by our website at any time by using the corresponding setting on the web browser they are using and thereby permanently reject cookies from being set. Configuring the browser in this way also prevents Google from setting cookies. Furthermore, through the Internet browser or other software, it is possible at any time to delete cookies already set by Google Analytics. It is also possible to object to (and prevent) the collection of data from Google Analytics on the use of this website, as well as the processing of this data by Google. Users who wish to do this can download and install a browser extension, available at <https://tools.google.com/dlpage/gaoptout>. This extension uses JavaScript to tell Google Analytics that transmission of data and information about visits to web pages to Google Analytics is not permitted. The installation of the browser extension is considered by Google as a refusal. If at a later time the information technology system of the data subject is deleted, formatted or reinstalled, the data subject must again perform the installation of the browser extension to deactivate Google Analytics. If the browser extension is uninstalled or deactivated by the data subject or by another person subordinate to him, it can be installed again or reactivated. Facebook retargeting services are integrated on our website which we use to inform our existing contacts (by newsletter) about our services and which we activate according to the interest of the individual: Facebook Retargeting allows personalised advertising to be created for the user, allowing the user to view relevant ads. The processing takes place on the legal basis of legitimate interest (Article 6 (1) (f) GDPR), with users able, on grounds relating to their particular situation, to exercise a right to object (Article 21 of the GDPR – for details see below, in the section on the rights of the data subject) in certain cases.

Retargeting on Facebook sets a cookie and a Facebook tracking pixel is integrated on our website. By setting this cookie, Facebook can recognise the visitor to our website when the visitor subsequently visits web pages that are themselves part of the Facebook advertising network. Each time a web page is visited which has integrated the Facebook retargeting service, the browser of the data subject automatically identifies itself to Facebook. As part of this technical process, Facebook gains knowledge of personal data, such as the user's IP address or browsing behaviour, which Facebook uses, for example, to display advertisements of interest to the user. As previously described, users can always block the use of cookies by our website at any time by using the corresponding setting on the web browser they are using and thereby permanently reject cookies from being set. Configuring the browser in this way also prevents Facebook from setting cookies. In addition, using the web browser or other software, it is possible at any time to delete cookies that have already been set by Facebook Retargeting.

The data protection policy/privacy policy published by Facebook, which can be consulted at <https://www.facebook.com/about/privacy>, provides information on the collection, processing and use of personal data by Facebook. It also explains what settings Facebook offers to protect the privacy of the data subject.

There are also several applications that can prevent data from being transmitted to Facebook. With these applications, users can prevent data from being transmitted to Facebook.

2. Contact using forms on the website, email or our call centre

- 2.1. You can contact us through our website, the contact forms on the website, or by email. The personal data that the user transmits to us – or that is collected – during this process is the data contained in the relevant contact form, or in the email. Our data processing also includes the time of contact, any response provided and any subsequent correspondence. There is no automated decision-making process, including profiling, pursuant to Article 22 (1 and 4) of the GDPR. The data is used exclusively for contact processing (Article 6 (1) (b) GDPR) and is kept for three years after the conclusion of the correspondence. The provision of this data is not required by law, but, without this data, it will not be possible to process the request. If it is necessary to conclude a contract on the basis of correspondence, the aforementioned data may be reprocessed, in some cases, on the basis of the archiving obligations provided for by law (Article 6 (1) (c) GDPR).

3. Processing of personal data – Call Centres

It is also possible to contact us by telephone at the offices of our laboratories or through our call centre.

Personal data will be processed for the purpose of providing the clinical analysis booking service, assistance and requests for information regarding the analysis service, as well as the management of appointments for specialist visits with geneticists.

The provision of personal data is necessary for the aforementioned purposes.

Any refusal by the data subject to communicate their personal data will make it impossible for the Laboratory to provide these services.

The data collected and processed by the Laboratory to fulfil the purposes referred to in paragraph 7.1 are: personal data and contact details for communications; user's payment details; health data.

The data collected will be processed and stored both on paper and with the aid of automated equipment in a manner strictly related to the aforementioned purposes and, in any case, in order to guarantee the security and confidentiality of the data for the period strictly necessary to achieve the purposes for which they were collected. In any case, the criterion used to determine this period is based on compliance with the time limits permitted by applicable laws and the principles of minimisation of processing.

The telephone conversation will not be recorded.

The data will be processed by the internal staff of the Laboratory acting as processors. Some data processing may also be carried out, acting as processors, by personnel of subsidiaries, parent companies or associates, or partners of the aforementioned, and by personnel appointed to carry out outsourced services on behalf of the Laboratory.

4. Our Newsletter

- 4.1. On our website, users can also subscribe to our newsletters – one for patients and one for doctors/health professionals – by providing their name and email address. In this case, use is made of a procedure known as 'double opt-in'. After registration, an email will be sent to the indicated email address, with a link to confirm the final registration. If the link is not clicked, the newsletter will not be sent. The dates of registration and confirmation, the dates that the newsletter is sent, any notification errors and data relating to the management of any cancellation are also included in the processing. The personal data collected as part of the newsletter subscription are used

exclusively for sending said newsletter, on the legal basis of consent (Article 6 (1) (a) GDPR). There is no automated decision-making process, including profiling, pursuant to Article 22 (1 and 4) of the GDPR. It is possible to cancel the subscription to our newsletter at any time, or to withdraw consent to it being sent. This means that the user's data will be processed until this cancellation and, as soon as this is carried out, the data is deleted immediately. Each newsletter contains a link allowing consent to be withdrawn. It is also possible to request cancellation using the contact details mentioned above – see also below, under the section on the rights of data subjects. There is no legal obligation to subscribe to our newsletter. In the absence of a subscription, however, no newsletter can be sent to the user.

- 4.2. Our newsletters contain tracking pixels. A tracking pixel is a miniature graphic that is integrated into emails sent in HTML format to enable log file recording and analysis. Using the integrated tracking pixel, we can tell if and when an email was opened and which links in it were visited. These personal data recorded via the tracking pixels contained in the newsletters are evaluated by us in the form of pseudonymous data and for statistical purposes, in order to optimise the sending of newsletters. The processing takes place on the legal basis of legitimate interest (Article 6 (1) (f) GDPR), with users able, on grounds relating to their particular situation, to exercise a right to object (Article 21 of the GDPR – for details see below, in the section on the rights of the data subject) in certain cases.
- 4.3. The following service providers, which we use to provide our newsletter services, have access in some cases to user data ('recipients' within the meaning of the GDPR) as part of the provision of their services. By contract, they are required to comply strictly with data protection standards:

Rocket Science Group LLC, headquartered in the United States, also known as "Mailchimp" for sending the newsletter by email and managing the email addresses. This service provider offers adequate guarantees regarding data protection pursuant to the adequacy decision of the European Commission and its certification in accordance with the Agreement known as the EU-US Privacy Shield (certification and status of the provider can be found at this link:

5. Data processing as part of our laboratory/analysis activity

- 5.1. If the user instructs us to carry out a laboratory/analysis activity, we process, as a rule and if necessary, (your) health data. For information about this, see the necessary separate consent and the related separate data protection policy here: www.lifebrain.it

6. Our "online reports"

- 6.1. Our website also offers the user the opportunity to register for our "Online Reports" service to be able to view and download their own reports. To register, the user must enter the password communicated by us in the registration process, during which the user expressly gives us their consent to the processing of health data in the context of our "Online reports" service, together with their username and tax code. The user can also authorise healthcare professionals/doctors to view their private section, or their reports, in the "Online Reports" area. For the purpose of providing the service and on this legal basis (Article 6 (1) (b) GDPR), together with the explicit consent of the data subject pursuant to

Article 9 (2) (a) GDPR), we process the aforementioned data and user reports, as well as the data collected by us in the use of the "Online reports" service, or the time and IP addresses of accesses and activities of the user related to the service. There is no automated decision-making process, including profiling, pursuant to Article 22 (1 and 4) of the GDPR. The user is not required, by law, to register for the "Online Reports" service, nor to communicate the related data. However, in the absence of this registration, the service cannot be provided.

- 6.2. The registration and consent to the "Online reports" service can be withdrawn by the user at any time by sending an email to gdpr@lifebrain.it – see also the section below on the rights of data subjects. We process the aforementioned data until consent is withdrawn and – for individual reports – for a maximum of 30 days following its upload online.
- 6.3. The following service providers that we use to provide our "Online Reports" service, in some cases have access to user data ('recipients' within the meaning of the GDPR) as part of the provision of their services. By contract, they are required to comply strictly with data protection standards:

7. "Work with us": Your applications

- 7.1. On our website, the user can also view vacancies and immediately submit their application for them. For the purposes of the selection procedure and on this legal basis (Article 6 (1) (b) GDPR), in some cases together with the explicit consent of the data subject pursuant to Article 9 (2) (a) GDPR), we process the data mentioned above, including, in some cases, the user's CV, as well as the data collected by us in the context of the application, or time and IP addresses of the application, any additional correspondence, assessment as part of the selection process, any invitations and interviews, and any transition to data processing under the employment contract. There is no automated decision-making process, including profiling, pursuant to Article 22 (1 and 4) of the GDPR. There are legal and (pre) contractual obligations for the user to provide data. If the data is not provided, it will not be possible to carry out the selection process or to enter into an employment contract with the user.
- 7.2. The user can revoke their consent at any time by sending an email to gdpr@lifebrain.it – see also the section below on the rights of data subjects. We process user data as part of the application until it is withdrawn and for a maximum of six months following the conclusion of the selection procedure.

8. Information on data protection rights of data subjects

For all the purposes of data processing described above, the user can exercise the following rights:

- 8.1. Right to withdraw consent: If the processing of the user's data is based on their consent, they have the right to withdraw it at any time, without prejudice to the lawfulness of the processing carried out on the basis of the consent up to the time of withdrawal. The procedures for communicating the withdrawal are indicated in the user's individual declarations of consent. The user can also withdraw individual consents as follows: Consent can be revoked at any time by sending an email to the -mail address dpo@lifebrain.it or by sending a letter to the contact details indicated above.
- 8.2. Right to information: You have the right to receive confirmation from us as to whether or not your personal data is being processed. In this case, the user has the right to be informed about this personal data (copy of the personal data being processed) and to access the following information: (a) the purposes of the processing; (b) the categories of personal data being processed; (c) the recipients or categories of recipients to whom the personal data have been or will be disclosed; (d) when possible, the retention period of the personal data provided or, if not possible, the criteria used to determine this period; (e) the existence of the right to request the rectification or erasure of personal data or the restriction of processing by us or to object to its processing; (f) the right to lodge a complaint with a supervisory authority; (g) if the data is not obtained from the data subject, all available information on its origin; (h) the (non) existence of an automated decision-making process, including profiling. In this regard, we will provide one copy of the personal data being processed. For all other requested copies, we may require, in certain cases, a reasonable fee based on administrative costs. If the request is sent by the data subject electronically, the information must be provided by us in a commonly used electronic format, unless otherwise indicated.
- 8.3. Right to rectification and erasure: The data subject has the right to obtain from us the correction of inaccurate personal data concerning them without undue delay. Taking into account the purposes of the processing, the data subject has the right to have incomplete personal data completed, including by providing a supplementary statement. The data subject also has the right to obtain from us the erasure of personal data concerning them without undue delay and we are required to erase the personal data without undue delay, if one of the following reasons exists: (a) the personal data are no longer necessary in relation to the purposes for which they were collected or otherwise processed; (b) the data subject withdraws the consent on which the processing is based and there is no other legal basis for the processing; (c) the data subject successfully objects to (see also below) the processing of the data; (d) the personal data has been unlawfully processed; (e) the erasure of the personal data is necessary to comply with a legal obligation that we are required to comply with; (f) the personal data has been collected in relation to the offer of information society services (consent of a minor). The right to erasure, in particular, does not exist if the processing is necessary to fulfil our legal obligation/or to establish, exercise or defend a right through the courts.
- 8.4. Right to restriction of processing: The data subject has the right to request the restriction of processing when one of the following conditions is met: (a) the data subject is contesting the accuracy of the personal data, for the period necessary for us to verify the accuracy of such personal data;
(b) the processing is unlawful and the data subject opposes the erasure of personal data and requests instead that its use be restricted; (c) although we no longer need it for processing

purposes, the personal data are necessary for the data subject – upon presentation of a duly motivated declaration – to ascertain, exercise or defend a right in court; or (d) the data subject has objected to the processing pending verification of the possible prevalence of our legitimate reasons as the data controller with respect to those of the data subject. Where processing is restricted, such personal data shall, except for storage, only be processed with the consent of the data subject or for the establishment, exercise or defence of legal claims, or for the protection of the rights of another natural or legal person, or for reasons of substantial public interest of the Union or of a Member State. The data subject who has obtained a restriction of the processing will be informed by us before this restriction is lifted.

- 8.5. Right to data portability: If the processing is based on consent or on a contract and is carried out by automated means, the data subject has the right to receive the data concerning them and provided to us in a structured, commonly used and machine-readable format. In exercising their rights relating to the portability of data, the data subject has the right to have their personal data transmitted directly from us to another data controller, if technically feasible.
- 8.6. Right to object: The data subject has the right to object at any time, for reasons connected to their particular situation, to the processing of personal data concerning them necessary for the execution of a task of public interest or connected to the exercise of public powers assigned to us, or necessary for the purpose of safeguarding our legitimate interests or those of third parties. In that case, we will refrain from further processing the personal data, unless we can demonstrate the existence of compelling legitimate reasons to proceed with the processing that prevail over the interests, rights and freedoms of the data subject or for the verification, the exercise or defence of a right in court. Furthermore, if personal data is processed for direct marketing purposes, the data subject has the right at any time to object to the processing of their personal data for such purposes. If the data subject objects to processing for direct marketing purposes, the personal data shall no longer be processed for such purposes.
- 8.7. Right to lodge a complaint with the supervisory authority: Without prejudice to any other administrative or judicial appeal, the data subject who believes that the processing that concerns them violates the provisions of the law, has the right to lodge a complaint with a supervisory authority, in particular in the Member State of their habitual residence, place of work or place of the alleged infringement.
